Getting To The Festival

Your chosen campsite is Live-In Vehicle so **NEW FOR 2022** you will enter via **BLUE GATE**. Use our Festival Map to help you find your way.

By Vehicle

Use postcode OX7 3HL.

On approach, Yellow AA road signs will guide you into the festival. When you see these, please follow signs for Blue Route and you will be directed down the new Haul Road directly to the Live-In Vehicle Campsite. Make sure you have your Live-In Vehicle Pass (posted to you in advance) completed and clearly displayed in your vehicle for arrival. If you have any issues with your Live-In Vehicle Pass, ensure you have your booking confirmation ready to show on arrival. Vehicles are parked as they arrive, so if you have a group you'd like to stay next to please arrive together.

By Train & Shuttle Bus

Charlbury is the local station, with regular trains from London Paddington. From here you can walk to the festival, it's approx. 1.5miles, but please be aware countryside roads are winding. Shuttle Busses will be running throughout the weekend, between Charlbury station and the festival.

By Coach

Big Green Coach offer a return service from London Victoria Coach Station. Leaving 10:00 Thursday 4th. Returning 10:00 Monday 8th. Book here.

By Bike

Join Red Fox Cycling's Ride to Wilderness, starting in Richmond London, continuing through picture-perfect rural Oxfordshire. There is a bike park next to the PUDO Box Office. Bikes are left at your own risk. <u>Book here.</u>

Arrival and Check In

Once you're parked, head to the Live-In Vehicle Box Office to exchange your mobile QR code ticket for your live-in vehicle festival wristband. Please don't rely on signal at the festival. Save your mobile QR code tickets to your phone wallet app in advance.

Alcohol Limits

You can bring the following into the campsite: 12 cans beer / lager / cider / pre-mixed drinks **OR** 2 bottles of wine (decanted into plastic bottles) **OR** A combination of both i.e. 6 cans and 1 bottle

Anything over that permitted will be confiscated, we do not have a service to return this. Your alcohol allowance can only be brought in upon **first entry**. You cannot leave and return with more. Searches will be undertaken on entry. These can only be consumed in the campsites. No outside alcohol in the arena. Strictly no spirits or hard liquor. Bar staff have the right to refuse service if you cannot produce valid I.D.

Restricted Items - Read our full list before packing.

Your Campsite

All our campsites have toilets, showers and water points. Any awnings or soft structures must fit within your designated 6x7m pitch. There is no re-entry for Live-In Vehicles during the festival.

Protecting Our Beautiful Home

The Lakes

Use of the lakes is only permitted during the lake opening hours 08:00*-18:00 (*from 14:00 Thursday). No detergents, glitter, chemicals or inflatables in the lakes. Please shower before entering. Only use biodegradable glitter and always remove this with a face wipe that you dispose of properly, don't wash it off, it goes in the water stream.

Litter & Recycling

Use the bins provided. There's a 3 bin system across the festival to separate Compostable, Recyclable and Not Recyclable waste, please use these correctly.

Going Home (to prepare for next year...)

Sunday night will still be full of fun, but we ask that you vacate campsites by midday on Monday. Take everything with you and properly dispose of any rubbish. Please respect our wonderful neighbours when leaving, they are kind enough to host us every year so please repay that kindness. Drive carefully, leave quietly and do not to drop any litter.
